For the 2022 ecumenical campaign, we will again be exploring the topic of climate justice. Particularly, we are turning our mind to renewable energies. In Switzerland, collective overconsumption means that we consume far too much energy. It is a bellows to the fire of global warming.

Without electricity there is no light, no fridge, no mobile phone. Access to energy is essential for the right to food and thus an important aspect in the fight against poverty. Electric lights help children to learn for school in the evenings and improve their education, and energy must be found for cooking food, all while conserving resources as much as possible.

In the global south, increasing climatic extremes such as droughts or floods are already posing a very real threat to current and future generations. The global link between our overconsumption of energy and extreme weather conditions is also featured on the campaign poster with the motto "**Wasted energy causes flooding**".

In the global north, we call for an enduring transition to sustainable and renewable energies and we advocate a reduction in energy consumption. In the global south, the struggle is for access to clean energy that will help people escape poverty. Together, let us take greater responsibility for our energy needs. *Together* means that we can and must contribute to a sustainable way of living for us all.
